- When provided copies of records showing any scientific test, I will investigate to see if the equipment was functioning properly and that the person giving the test was properly certified.
- Proof must be shown that you were advised of all of your rights. I will test the reliability of such advisement.

As you can see, what looks simple can be very complicated. Investigation may be required, as well as contact with expert witnesses.

Every aspect of your case will be scrutinized and examined and “when appropriate” challenged in court proceedings.
